



Inspired by the experience of coming together, COLLECTIVE recognises dining as a shared experience. From simple family meals to abundant dinner parties, a symbol of connection and community.

COLLECTIVE is a mixed-material collection of tableware which enhances different environments, cuisines and occasions. Gently tapered forms with relaxed, low profiles bring a contemporary aesthetic to porcelain tableware. The versatile pieces are designed to be used together, selected to complement each other and various settings, allowing individuals to curate their own unique table and reflect their personal style.

From simple family meals to abundant dinner parties, COLLECTIVE offers pieces which welcome everyone to the table.



MATERIALS & MAKING

PORCELAIN

Porcelain is made from a mix of kaolin clay and mineral-rich rock; these essential minerals, including quartz and feldspar, give porcelain its characteristic translucency and strength.

The complex production combines the latest technology with traditional techniques. Natural raw materials from Europe and a double firing process create products that are safe, durable and easy to care for, even in demanding environments.

Plates and bowls are machine pressed and backstamps are positioned and applied by hand. Natural pigments are used to create the glaze.

Cups, mugs, salad bowls and jugs are formed in bespoke moulds. Handles are cast separately and then positioned and applied by hand. Rough areas and uneven surfaces are removed by hand.

Once the object is formed, it is sent for its first firing to harden the body for handling prior to glazing. The object is then glazed and fired again at a higher temperature, strengthening the structure, vitrifying the surface and rendering it impermeable. The backstamp logo is applied by hand before refiring. Pieces are sorted and inspected before they are boxed.

COLLECTIVE porcelain is made in an energy conscious production facility that cooperates with the local community to minimise environmental impact. Waste water is reused and recycled during the production process. Thermal energy from the kilns is channelled into a central heating system, with residual heat used to heat local housing or a local school.

All of our products meet the highest standards of food and materials safety checks ensuring they are durable, versatile and safe to use in both home and professional settings.

Inspired by the potential of materials and conscious of provenance and craft, we work collaboratively with our trusted partners and team of designers. Our combined experience allows us to design to the strengths of each material and experiment with different techniques, pushing the boundaries of production. Designing for the present, using considered techniques giving clarity to our modern design aesthetic, without compromising the future.

MATERIALS & MAKING

WOOD

The ash wood is sustainably-sourced from European forests certified by the Forest Stewardship Council®.

Dry wood, is cut into batons of different shapes and sizes and glued together, preventing warping and cracking. Surfaces, corners and edges are sanded by hand at multiple stages for a smooth finish.

GLASS

Many of the traditional techniques used to make glass are still in practise today. Glass can be melted infinitely without reducing its quality, making it a circular and infinitely recyclable material. Skilled glassblowers work in teams, with each person responsible for a different element of the process—training for years to perfect their craft.


High quality raw materials are melted in the furnace. Glass is gathered, shaped and then mouth-blown into a wooden mould.

The rim of each dome is melted to achieve a soft, smooth finish. The large, tapered bowls are mouth blown from coloured glass, cased in clear. The rims are cut and polished by hand to achieve a flat edge and smooth, modern finish.
